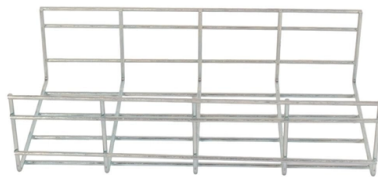


# Viewing the routing table on the core switch
