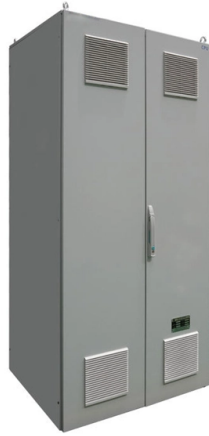


West Africa Fiber Optic Cable Monitoring

This interactive submarine cable map shows the global undersea fiber optic cables connecting world. Learn more about West African Cable System (WACS). The WACS consists of four fibre pairs. It was initially designed with 128 wavelengths per fiber pair, running at 10 Gbps per wavelength, and initial. The West Africa Cable System (WACS) is a 14530km submarine cable system connecting 15 countries, starting from South Africa and ending in London. WACS was supplied by ASN, and completed in 2012. Explore cable routes, landing stations and system status. The cable failures left 13 African countries with either disrupted internet services or near-complete outages, with the worst of the disturbances centered in West Africa.
