Connector Colors

Single-mode fiber connectors also use color coding to indicate the polish type:

- Blue connectors: Indicate UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) polish, which has a flat endface and provides low insertion loss and back reflection. UPC connectors are commonly used for general long-distance single-mode links, including telecom and backbone networks .
