

What colors are pigtail fibers

Standard Color Coding

Fiber optic pigtails follow the TIA/EIA-598-A color standard to identify fiber types and individual fibers within a bundle. The color coding helps technicians quickly identify and manage fibers during splicing and installation.

- Single-mode fibers (OS2): Yellow outer sheath, suitable for long-distance transmission (1310nm or 1550nm wavelengths) up to 10–40 km.

 - OM1/OM2: Orange outer sheath, typically used for short-distance connections (850nm wavelength, up to 500m)
 - OM3/OM4: Aqua outer sheath, optimized for higher-speed short-distance applications (850nm wavelength, up to 550m for OM3 and 600m for OM4)

Multi-Fiber Pigtails

For multi-fiber pigtails, each individual fiber is color-coded within the bundle to allow easy identification. The TIA/EIA-598-A standard assigns colors in the following sequence for the first 12 fibers: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. For fiber counts above 12, the color sequence repeats with stripes to differentiate additional fibers.
