

What is the black box in the middle of the optical cable



Overview

An ONT (Optical Network Terminal) is a white or black box installed on the wall during your Full Fibre installation. The fiber optic cable entering your home connects to the ONT through the wall. A fiber-optic cable, also known as an optical-fiber cable, is an assembly similar to an electrical cable but containing one or more optical fibers that are used to carry. The tiny cylinder on the cable goes by a lot of names, such as ferrite bead, ferrite core, ferrite choke, or EMI filter. As you can guess from the name, it's made of ferrite, which is a magnetic material composed of iron oxide. The main purpose of these ferrite beads is to block electromagnetic. A fiber optic cable consists of five basic components: the core, the cladding, the coating, the strengthening fibers, and the cable jacket.
