

What is the spacing between optical cables

Attached optical cables typically require a minimum midspan clearance of 12 inches from neutral conductors and 30 inches at pole supports, with additional spacing depending on voltage, attachment method, and local standards.

General Guidelines

Midspan and pole clearances for aerial fiber optic cables are primarily governed by the National Electrical Safety Code (NESC) and reinforced by utility-specific construction standards. For example, the NESC allows a midspan clearance of 12 inches (300 mm) between neutral conductors and steel messengers supporting fiber-optic cables when the messenger is bonded to the supply neutral, while maintaining 30 inches (0.75 m) at the pole between the neutral conductor and the highest communication attachment (communication messenger). Minimum clearances to ground and energized conductors are also specified: a minimum of 18 feet above traveled roads and 40 inches from energized conductors or neutrals unless otherwise specified by utility construction drawings. These clearances ensure safety for both installation personnel and the public.

Standards and Best Practices

- FOA Installation Standards recommend proper attachment to existing anchors only with permission, avoiding auxiliary eye attachments, and following construction drawings for strand height and spacing.
