

# What is the upstream switch of the distribution box

- In residential or small commercial setups, the upstream switch is usually a double-pole MCB or main switch installed inside the distribution box itself .
- In industrial or large commercial systems, the upstream switch may be located in a switchboard or upstream panel, feeding power to multiple distribution boxes .
