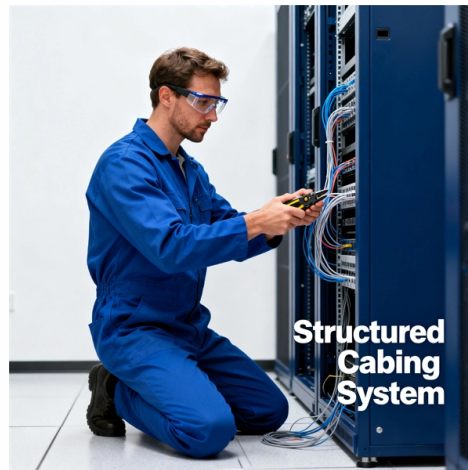


What precautions should be taken when removing the outer sheath of the pigtail fiber



Overview

Use caution to avoid cutting the ripcord and outer strength members under the cable sheath. Gently flex the cable at the ring cut to separate the sheath. Do not apply more pulling force to the cable than. Therefore, when choosing a cutter, a skilled operator should use a manual cutter for quick cable connection or rescue at room temperature; for beginners or when working in colder conditions in the field, an electric cutter should be used. Always make sure to properly maintain your stripping tools, regardless of the ones you use, to keep the cutting blades sharp. 2 Strip the PVC sheath from the cable, using a sharp knife for the distance given in the relevant joint.
