

What switch is used for PoE power supply

A PoE switch supplies DC power to connected devices over Ethernet cables according to IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt standards, eliminating the need for separate power adapters.

How PoE Switches Supply Power

PoE switches act as Power Sourcing Equipment (PSE), delivering power to Powered Devices (PDs) such as IP phones, cameras, wireless access points, and PoE lighting over standard Ethernet cables (Cat5, Cat5e, Cat6) while simultaneously transmitting data. The switch first detects whether a connected device supports PoE by sending a low-voltage detection pulse and measuring resistance. Once confirmed, the switch classifies the device into a power class (0-8) and gradually ramps the voltage to the full 48V DC, providing stable and reliable power.

PoE Standards

- IEEE 802.3af (PoE): Provides up to 15.4W per port, suitable for devices with low power requirements.
- IEEE 802.3at (PoE+): Provides up to 30W per port, supporting higher-power devices like PTZ cameras or access points.
- IEEE 802.3bt (PoE++ or Type 3/4): Provides up to 60-100W per port, designed for high-power IoT devices and smart building applications.

Power Delivery Modes

- Mode A (Endspan): Power is delivered over the same pairs used for data transmission (pins 1-2 and 3-6).
