Mounting Options: Junction boxes can be wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or rack-mounted (e.g., 19" 1U telescopic distribution frames), providing flexibility for different network layouts .

Electrical and Hybrid Integration: Certain models, such as those from Glenair, support hybrid optical/electrical architectures, incorporating backshells, fiber media protection conduits, and electrical connectors for high-speed communication systems .
