

# Where does the cable tray connect

- **Splice Plates:** Metal plates bolted across tray ends to join sections securely .
- **Clamps and Brackets:** Used at bends, tees, and risers to hold trays in place and maintain alignment .
- **Grounding Connections:** Ensure continuity of the grounding path, especially for metal trays, in compliance with NEC Article 392 .
