To use a fiber optic cable, you must insert a compatible optical SFP module into the SFP port. These modules convert the electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for transmission over fiber. There are two main types:

- Multimode SFP: Suitable for shorter distances (typically up to 550 meters).
- Single-mode SFP: Suitable for long distances (up to tens of kilometers). Ensure the SFP module matches the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and connector type (LC, SC, etc.) of your fiber cable.
