They are ideal for high-density setups, separating copper and fiber links while maintaining consistent bend-radius control. Vertical managers prevent cable sagging, reduce strain on terminations, and help maintain a clean, organized rack layout .

Brush Panels

Brush panels are used at cable entry and exit points to reduce dust intrusion and provide strain relief. They allow cables to pass through while maintaining a neat front appearance and protecting connections from excessive bending or stress .
