

Which conduit should be connected first for the ribbon fiber optic cable connector

Lubrication should be applied to both the cable jacket and conduit interior to reduce friction, especially for ribbon cables, which are more sensitive to stress . Finally, connect the conduit at the cable feed or source end. Pulling from the termination end toward the source allows better control of tension and reduces the likelihood of kinking or damaging the ribbon fibers during installation . For very long or complex runs, mid-span access points can be used to manage tension and re-lubricate the cable as needed .
