A low-voltage (LV) distribution box receives power from a transformer or main supply and distributes it to multiple circuits while providing overload, short-circuit, and fault protection. The box ensures safe control, fault isolation, and monitoring of electrical loads in offices, industrial plants, or infrastructure ().

- **Incoming Supply and Main Circuit Breaker:** The main breaker connects the LV box to the transformer or upstream supply, providing primary protection and isolation ().
- **Busbars:** Copper or aluminum busbars distribute power to outgoing feeders. Busbar sizing depends on the short-circuit current rating and load requirements ().
- **Outgoing Circuit Breakers:** Branch circuit breakers protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits. Selection depends on load type, current rating, and selectivity ().
- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs) / Arc Fault Detection Devices (AFDDs):** Optional devices for additional safety against earth faults or arc faults ().
