Overview

Terminal crimping is the process of joining a wire to a terminal connector using mechanical pressure rather than soldering. The crimp tool compresses the terminal's metal sleeve around the stripped wire, creating a gas-tight seal that prevents corrosion and ensures reliable. The following is a guide to basic crimp techniques - designed to provide for quality terminations and to prevent poor connections. Funnel entry Colour code matched to crimp tool cavity identifier RBY. This compression joint provides reliable conductivity and mechanical strength essential for electrical circuits in automotive, marine, and industrial. Place the terminal with the wire into the crimping tool, ensuring it's correctly aligned in the crimping die. Wire strippers and ferrules help make strong and safe connections.
