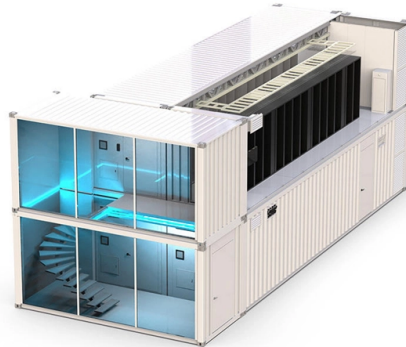


Wiring used in construction site distribution boxes

Proper wiring of construction site distribution boxes involves secure grounding, correct phase/neutral/ground connections, neat cable management, appropriate breaker sizing, and compliance with NEC and OSHA standards.

Selection and Placement of Distribution Boxes

Choose a distribution box suitable for the construction environment: industrial-grade, dustproof, and waterproof if outdoors, with proper IP/NEMA ratings for protection against moisture and dust . Install the box in a dry, accessible, and ventilated area, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters, away from flammable or corrosive materials . Ensure the box is level and securely mounted using expansion bolts or other stable fixtures .

Wiring Preparation and Connections

- **Wire Stripping and Length:** Strip insulation to an appropriate length; avoid leaving conductors too long or too short to prevent short circuits or poor contact .
- **Terminal Connections:** Connect phase wires to phase terminals, neutral wires to neutral terminals, and ground wires to grounding terminals. Use wire strippers or screw terminals to ensure tight, conductive connections .
- **Cable Management:** Route wires neatly inside the box, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid tangling or contact with sharp edges .
